ON-CAMPUS RECRUITMENT

Directory information and on-campus recruiting opportunities will be made available to all recruiters on an equal basis. These shall include representatives of the armed forces of the United States of America and state armed services, non-military recruiters, recruiters for commercial concerns and recruiters representing institutions of higher education.

If a parent/guardian, or a student who has attained majority status, notifies the principal in writing that directory information may not be provided to any such recruiters, the directory information regarding that student shall not be released.

The school administration shall make the determination as to the scheduling of recruitment meetings and reserves the right to deny such meetings where the holding of such meeting will materially and substantially interfere with the proper and orderly operation of the school.

Any person or organization denied the rights accorded under this policy shall have the right to request a review of the decision by the Board of Education by filing a written request with the Superintendent of Schools.
