DRUGS, TOBACCO, ALCOHOL INSTRUCTION

The use of drugs, tobacco and alcohol has a deleterious effect on the health and welfare of the users and far-reaching detrimental consequences to users, families, and society. Therefore, the knowledge, skills, and attitudes required to avoid the effects of alcohol, nicotine or tobacco and of drugs on health, character, citizenship and personality development shall be taught every academic year to all students in all grades.
