EMPLOYEE POLITICAL ACTIVITY

Employees are free to participate actively in political activity.

No employees shall engage in political activity while on duty. Employees engaging in political activity should make it clear that their views and actions are theirs as individuals and that they do not represent the views of the school system. Such employees shall not use school equipment, supplies or resources in their political activity.

The Superintendent may, but is not obligated to, make necessary arrangements for absence from the job as is necessary for each employee who holds political office on an individual basis, subject to the operational needs of the schools. In such event, the Superintendent shall determine the appropriate terms and conditions for such arrangement, including without limitation any issues regarding the employees' salary and job responsibilities.
