

Kindergarten Care Programs at Jerome Harrison and Stanley T. Williams Elementary Schools.

Our Kindergarten Care Programs accommodate a child's half-day kindergarten schedule by providing morning care for children in afternoon kindergarten and afternoon care for children in morning kindergarten.

The program is an enrichment program that is planned by the program's Head Teacher. In addition to the Head Teacher, the program is staffed with a Lead Teacher and 2 Teacher Assistants. All staff is CPR, First-Aide and Epi-Pen certified.

Children will take part in a variety of activities while in the program. All activities revolve around a specific weekly theme. Children will also have their snack and lunch during their time with us.

Our morning session of K-Care begins at the start of school, 8:50 am and ends at 12:30 pm. Children in this group will be walked to their afternoon kindergarten class. The afternoon session of K-Care begins at 11:35 am and ends at school dismissal time, 3:15 pm.

If you require extended childcare services, you have the option of enrolling your child in our after school program. Please see "School-Age Childcare" for more information on this program.

Registration for the Kindergarten Care Program takes place on the same day as the district's designated Kindergarten Registration day. We will have a separate table set-up on this day at both Jerome Harrison and Stanley T. Williams Schools, please stop by and see us for registration material.
