Long Range Planning

In order to obtain and maintain the educational facilities necessary to meet the mission of the Board of Education, a master plan shall be developed for the construction and maintenance of the North Branford School District facilities. The Board shall review this plan periodically, and the plan will be changed as necessary. The plan shall reflect the needs of current instructional procedures and projected educational programming and shall incorporate population projections, enrollment projections, site acquisition needs, school plant placement, and financial estimates of providing necessary school facilities.

The master facilities plan shall include how the district will provide an appropriate learning environment for its students which includes (1) adequate instructional materials, equipment, staffing, facilities and technology, (2) equitable allocation of resources among its schools and (3) a safe school setting and (4) environmental issues, including indoor air quality. Attention shall also be given to how facilities can be utilized to improve academic achievement and to reduce racial, ethnic and economic isolation or to preserve racial and ethnic balance.
