COOPERATING MENTOR AND ASSESSOR TEACHERS

The North Branford Board of Education recognizes the importance of supporting and training new and student teachers in their education and professional development. The District shall participate, pursuant to C.G.S. §10-220a, in the State Department of Education's cooperating, mentor and assessor programs. The programs are designed to (a) provide assistance to student teachers by cooperating teachers, (b) give support to beginning teachers by mentor teachers and assessment by assessors. In addition, the Board is committed to providing teaching opportunities and training for student teachers and teaching interns as appropriate.

The provisions of C.G.S. §10-220a are adopted to implement the cooperating teacher program and beginning educator support and training program.
