New Construction Naming Facilities

Schools and school facilities shall normally be named for:

1. persons who have attained prominence locally and/or nationally;
2. persons who are important names in education, science, art, statesmanship, political science, or military achievement;
3. persons who were early pioneers of the community or the State of Connecticut;
4. persons who are/were outstanding presidents of the United States of America;
5. geographical landmarks

General procedures for selecting a school name shall be as follows:

1. The Board shall appoint a committee of two citizens from the immediate community to be served by the particular school or facility and one representative from each of the following groups: teachers, administrators, PTA/PTO, and two student representatives from the area to be served (for high school facilities only) A Board member shall be designated to be a member of this committee.
2. The school-naming committee shall present a list of not less than three names nor more than five names to the Superintendent who will forward them to the Board.
3. The Board shall then make the final selection of the name.
