SCHOOL TRANSPORTATION PRIVILEGES AND CONDUCT

School transportation privileges are extended to students conditional upon their satisfactory behavior on the school bus.

A code of behavior shall be published annually for students. Students shall be advised that they may be suspended from transportation services for unsatisfactory conduct while awaiting or receiving transportation to and from school which endangers persons or property or violates a Board Policy or Administrative Regulation.

If a student loses his/her transportation privileges, he/she shall be allowed to ride home that day only. Students who lose transportation privileges are required to attend school and it is the responsibility of parents to see that the students are in school. Administrators shall conduct an informal hearing with the student in each such case and shall notify parents that transportation privileges are suspended.
