SCHOOL VISITORS

Parents and guardians of students attending the North Branford Public Schools and Board of Education members are encouraged to visit the North Branford Public Schools at appropriate times to become acquainted with students, school personnel, and programs. Parents and community members may visit schools with prior approval of the principal and for a specified and approved purpose.

All school visitors shall register in the Principal's office. Staff members should be alert for unauthorized visitors and report their presence to the principal promptly. It is expected that all school visitors will demonstrate proper decorum and not be disruptive of the educational process; otherwise, school visitors will be asked to leave the school premises.

A person who loiters or remains in or about a school building, or grounds, without a reason or relationship involving custody of, or responsibility for, a student or any other license or privilege to be there is guilty of loitering.
