SECURITY

The North Branford Board of Education recognizes the importance of security for all school property and shall cause the administration to take all reasonable actions to protect such property. Security includes, but is not limited to, the securing of buildings when not in use; protection against vandalism and burglary; protection from fire hazards and faulty equipment; safe electrical, plumbing, and heating practices; and maintenance of records in safe places.

The Superintendent of Schools, administrative, maintenance and custodial personnel shall cooperate with police, fire departments, and insurance company inspectors to make school buildings as safe as reasonably possible.

To help assure the security of school buildings and grounds:

1. adequate key control systems shall be established to limit building access to authorized personnel.
2. funds and valuable records shall be kept in safe places and under lock and key.

The Superintendent of Schools, or his/her designee, shall determine the need for security at all school events.
