SUBSTITUTE TEACHERS

Substitute teachers shall be employed for short periods of time in the absence of the regular teacher. A substitute teacher shall hold Connecticut State Certification as a teacher. In the event that a certified substitute teacher is not available, the Superintendent of Schools may employ a qualified and competent person without certification for a period not to exceed 40 days (except in the event that a waiver is obtained) in the same assignment in any one school year.

Building principals shall supervise the assignments, orientation and evaluation of substitute teachers.

Rates of compensation for substitute teachers will be set periodically by the Board of Education.

Substitute teachers will not participate in the health and welfare plans or other fringe benefits of the school system, except in limited situations where the Superintendent, in his/her sole discretion, may provide sick days to a substitute teacher.

Retired teachers may be employed as substitute teachers without jeopardizing their retirement Salary within the limits as prescribed by law.
