SUMMER SCHOOL

The North Branford Board of Education may provide summer school programs of remediation or enrichment courses at all grade levels. Enrichment courses carry no credit. Student attendance at summer school shall be voluntary, and transportation is the responsibility of parents/guardian. Admission to summer school classes must be approved by the program director following review with the principal, in accordance with criteria established by the school district.

The North Branford Board of Education may charge each child attending a summer program a reasonable fee not to exceed the cost of the program.

Non residents may enroll in the Board's summer school program, so long as space is available.

The provisions of this policy do not apply to a student who is eligible for special education services and who is placed in a summer program by the Planning and Placement Team.
