All programs are staffed with a Head Teacher, and Teacher Assistants. The Head Teacher is responsible for planning all activities. We maintain a 10:1 Teacher to student ratio at all times. Teachers are certified in CPR, First Aid and Epi-Pen.

- To provide a quality childcare program that is available during times school is not in session and that is affordable and accessible to families needing the service.
- To help children make friends and learn how to get along with others.
- To provide activities that offer opportunities for choice and success for each child in the program.
- To work cooperatively with parents toward common goals for their child/children.
